A month before the festival, the park will be transformed into *The Enchanting Village*.

Teatret OM's permanent set designer Antonella Diana leads a team of international artists who together create a unique and sustainable festival environment.

Art and wild nature infiltrate the park in the form of installations, bio-architecture and land art.

The underlying theme is community, and here Alkjær Lukke will become a place where the international artist group meets the locals; a place where we gather and celebrate Mother Earth.
